hold joint press conference**

Las Vegas, NV (September 6, 2007) – With The Palazzo prominently featured in the background, business mogul Jay-Z and Palazzo President Rob Goldstein held a joint press conference today to announce The Palazzo as the future home of the 40/40 Club. The first 40/40 Club in Las Vegas and the more than 3,000 suite Palazzo will open the same day on December 20, 2007.

In addition to the main room, the new club also offers 5 exclusive VIP rooms that fans of the 40/40 club have become accustomed to in New York City. The interior consists of 24kt gold and platinum floors, as well as five, 40 foot bi-level bars throughout the club. The space will also include an additional 3,000 square foot bar and lounge area on the outdoor terrace.

The Palazzo is a stand-alone resort currently being built by Las Vegas Sands Corp. (NYSE:LVS) in the heart of the famed Las Vegas Strip. When combined with the neighboring Venetian and Sands Expo and Convention Center, The Palazzo will give the company the largest hotel and convention complex in the world. In addition to Jersey Boys, the \$1.8 billion Palazzo will feature more than 3,000 all-suite rooms and offer its new shopping, dining and entertainment on two luxurious levels. The 450,000-square-foot retail space, The Shoppes at The Palazzo™ will be highlighted by Barneys New York and connected to The Venetian via The Grand Canal Shoppes. It will house approximately 60 high-end and mid-level stores from the most recognizable brands to the hottest newcomers and unique one-of-a-kind boutiques drawn from all over the world. Additionally, The Palazzo will offer 14 new restaurants from renowned chefs, many of whom are not yet featured in the Las Vegas area.
