## General Rules

1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Ten (10) minute break at the completion of every four (4) levels on Day 1. On Day 1A, play will continue until 15 levels have been played (approximately 830pm) or until we are down to approximately 11% of the field, whichever comes first. Day 1B, 1C, 1D, and 1E will stop at exactly the same spot, in accord with the tournament clock, that Day 1A ended. Day 2 will resume at 11am combining all remaining players from Day 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, and 1E and continue until a winner has been declared.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
4. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
6. \$250 Buy-In starts with 15,000 chips. Levels 1 - 15 are thirty (30) minutes. Level 16 until the conclusion of the event are forty (40) minutes.
7. \$30 of \$250 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$15 of \$250 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee.
8. Registration and Re-Entries allowed for the first eight (8) levels and through the break. Any player who plays Day 1A may also play Day 1B, Day 1C, Day 1D, or Day 1E regardless if they busted or still remain in the tournament. After Day 1E, if a player has chips remaining from Day 1A, Day 1B, Day 1C, Day 1D or Day 1E, only the greater chip stack will move forward to Day 2. The lesser of the chip stacks shall be removed from play.
9. A prize pool of \$250,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room.
10. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
11. Late entries do not have to wait for the Big Blind to play their first hand.
12. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazier card to play.
