General Rules

1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to participate.
3. Ten (10) minute break at the completion of every four (4) levels.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
5. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042s forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
7. \$200 Buy-In Start with 12,000 in chips. Each level is 30 minutes.
8. \$26 of \$200 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$14 of \$200 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee.
9. Registration and one (1) Optional \$200 ReBuy is allowed until the end of the fourth (4th) level and through the break. There are no Re-Entries allowed for this event.
10. One (1) Optional \$200 Rebuy is allowed anytime a player is at or below 12,000 chips within the first four levels. If a player is completely out of chips, they must Rebuy before the start of the next hand, or they will be eliminated from the tournament. \$10 of the \$200 Rebuy will be withheld for the Entry Fee. Each Rebuy is 12,000 chips.
11. A total prize pool of \$20,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room. The total prize pool will consist of \$160 of every \$200 Buy In and \$190 of every \$200 Rebuy.
12. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
13. Late entries do not have to wait for the Big Blind to play their first hand.
14. This is a one (1) day tournament.
