General Rules

1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Ten (10) minute break at the completion of levels 3, 6, and 12. There will be a thirty (30) Min dinner break at the completion of level 9, which will be approximately 630pm. Play will continue until 14 levels have been played. Day two will resume play at 11am and continue until a winner has been declared.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
4. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042s forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
6. \$300 Buy-In starts with 12,000 in chips 40 minute levels.
7. \$34 of the \$300 Buy In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$18 of the \$300 Buy In will be withheld for Staff Fee.
8. Registration and Re-Entries are allowed for the first six (6) levels and through the break.
9. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
10. A total prize pool of \$25,000 in guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room.
11. Late entries after the first fifteen minutes (15 min) of play will receive a full starting stack, however, they will not be allowed to play until it is their big blind or they choose to post their Big Blind from any position except in-between the button and the small blind.
12. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to play.
