General Rules

1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to play.
3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of levels 3, 6, and 12. There will be a sixty (60) minute break after level nine (9). On Day 1, play will continue until 15 levels have been played. Day 2 will resume at 1:00pm and will continue until a winner has been declared.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
5. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
7. \$1,600 Buy-In starts with 20,000 chips. Levels 1-18 are forty (40) minutes. Levels 19 until conclusion are sixty (60) minutes. Heads Up each level is thirty (30) minutes.
8. \$100 of \$1,600 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$55 of \$1,600 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee. The prize pool will consist of \$1,445 of every \$1,600 Buy In.
9. Players receive \$500 Bounty for each player they eliminate from the tournament. If two or more players eliminate another player from the tournament with the exact same hand, the \$500 Bounty Chip will be split equally amongst all winning hands.
10. Registration and Re-Entry is allowed for twelve (12) levels and through the break.
11. A total prize pool of \$700,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room. The total prize pool will consist of the posted prize amount plus the total of \$500 bounties that are awarded.
12. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
13. Late entries will be dealt in immediately.
