General Rules

1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to play.
3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of levels 3, 6, and 12. There will be a sixty (60) minute break after level nine (9). On Day 1A, play will continue until 15 levels have been played or until we are down to approximately 11% of the field, whichever comes first. Day 1B and 1C will stop at exactly the same spot, in accord with the tournament clock, that Day 1A ended. Day 2 will resume at 1:00pm combining all remaining players from Day 1A, 1B, 1C, and continue until a winner has been declared.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
5. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
7. \$800 Buy-In starts with 25,000 chips. Each level is forty (40) minutes.
8. \$70 of \$800 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$30 of \$800 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee. The prize pool will consist of \$700 of every \$800 Buy In.
9. Registration and Re-Entries allowed for nine (9) levels and through the break. Any player who plays Day 1A may also play Day 1B or 1C regardless if they busted or still remain in the tournament. After Day 1C, if a player has chips remaining from Day 1A, 1B, and 1C, only the greater chip stack will move forward to Day 2. The lesser of the chip stacks shall be removed from play.
10. A prize pool of \$800,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room.
11. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
12. Late entries will be dealt in immediately.
