1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Must be $21+$ years of age and have a Venetian Rewards card to participate.
3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of every three (3) levels.
4. Each starting flight will play until we are down to approximately $12.5 \%$ of the field remaining. Day 2 will resume at 11:00 AM combining all remaining players from $1 \mathrm{~A}, 1 \mathrm{~B}$, and 1 C with all players being considered in the money and will continue until a winner has been declared. To begin Day 2, the clock will revert to the earliest stoppage time of Day 1.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel or change the tournament.
6. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
7. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of $\$ 5,000$ or more (net of buy-in amount).
8. $\$ 1,600$ Buy In starts with 40,000 chips. Each level is forty (40) minutes.
9. $\$ 180$ of the $\$ 1,600$ Buy-In is withheld for house fees (Rake + Staff). The prize pool consists of $\$ 1,420$ of every $\$ 1,600$ Buy In. $\$ 500$ of every $\$ 1,420$ prize pool will be allotted as Mystery Bounty cash prizes. The total amount of Mystery Bounty cash prizes will be determined by the final number of registered players.
10. Registration and Re-Entry is allowed for nine (9) levels and through the break.
11. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.
12. Ante will come from the Big Blind Only. The Big Blind is posted before the Ante.
13. A Prize Pool of $\$ 1$ Million is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room. The prize pool will consist of the actual prize money awarded plus the total amount of Mystery Bounty cash prizes awarded.
14. Players who bag chips for Day 2 may not play a subsequent flight.
15. At the start of Day 2, any player who eliminates another player from the event will be awarded a Mystery Bounty slip, which will entitle them to select one Mystery Bounty envelope from our Drawing Drum, containing a Mystery Bounty cash prize ranging from $\$ 500$ to $\$ 100,000$. Cash prize amounts are at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director and all Mystery Bounty cash prizes will be posted in the poker room prior to the start of Day 2. All Mystery Bounty slips must be redeemed at the Drawing Drum located inside the poker room prior to the conclusion of the event. Mystery Bounty slips are the sole responsibility of the player, as any lost or stolen Mystery Bounty slips will not be replaced. All unclaimed Mystery Bounty envelope cash prizes will be forfeited and not awarded to an alternate player.
16. If two or more players eliminate another player from the tournament with the exact same hand, the Mystery Bounty cash prize will be split equally with all winning hands. The winning player with the worst position will draw the Mystery Bounty envelope from the drawing drum on behalf of all winning players.
17. On Day 2, at Tournament Directors Discretion, players will have twenty (20) seconds pre-flop and thirty (30) seconds post-flop to act on their hand through the use of a countdown clock. Based on Day 2 field size, players will receive the following timeextension chips, each worth a 30-second addition to a player's action:

Less than 45 players: 5-time extension chips.
46-72 players: 3 -time extension chips +3 at 27 players remaining.
73-99 players: 4 -time extension chips +3 at 27 players remaining.
$100+$ players: 5 -time extension chips +3 at 27 players remaining.
In the case that time expires for a player with remaining time-extension chips, the player's countdown clock will automatically extend an additional thirty (30) seconds. Collection of time-extension chips will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's countdown clock expires and the player does not have any time-extension chips remaining, he/she will be (a) forced to check, if there is no bet pending or (b) fold, if facing a bet or raise. Shot clocks will be removed at the Final Table.
18. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
