

JANUARY HIGH HAND GIVEAWAY RULES

1. The High Hand Giveaway is for all contributing Texas Hold 'em Poker Games.
2. Participating games include any Texas Hold 'em game, Limit or No Limit that is not a part of a Mix game, and does not have a time collection for rake.
3. Beginning January 1 through January 31, 2019, ("Designated Dates") each day The Venetian® Poker Room will award the player with the highest qualifying hand in any participating game a High Hand Giveaway of \$500. The Qualifying Period will begin at 12:00 p.m. and continue every 30 minutes until 11:30 p.m. on the designated days ("Qualifying Periods"). The first player to achieve the highest hand in each Qualifying Period will be paid \$500 in Casino Chips ("Initial Giveaway"). The Qualifying Period and hands reset each 30 minutes. The last Qualifying Period will be from 11:30 p.m., and the final payout will be at 12:00 a.m.
4. Any player with a qualifying hand that is equal to the Initial Giveaway in a Qualifying Period will be paid \$1,000 in Casino Chips ("Matching Giveaway"). In the event that the same player wins with both the Initial Giveaway, and a Matching Giveaway, in a single Qualifying Period, that player will win \$500 for the Initial Giveaway, and another \$1,000 for each subsequent Matching Giveaway.
5. Winner is permitted to add any portion of the Initial or Matching Giveaway to their current chip stack. Once one (1) hand is played after receiving their Initial or Matching Giveaway, standard table stakes rules apply.
6. To qualify for the High Hand Giveaway, a player must show a hand that is equal to, or stronger than, the currently posted High Hand. Only a full house or higher will qualify. The current qualifying hand, and any matching qualifying hands, will be announced and/or posted.
7. If a Bad Beat Jackpot is hit during the High Hand Giveaway, the Bad Beat Jackpot Winning Hand is eligible for that High Hand Giveaway.
8. A qualifying hand must be tabled by the player, and the hand must be complete, prior to the Qualifying Period ending, to be considered part of that Qualifying Period. Otherwise, if applicable, it will be considered part of the next Qualifying Period.
9. There must be at least \$10 in the pot, and a minimum of four players dealt in at the beginning of the hand, in order to qualify for the High Hand Giveaway.
10. A qualifying hand can use any five-card combination, provided they use both cards in their hand. It doesn't need to be the best five card hand. The player must win the entire main pot for which the qualifying hand was dealt.
11. In the event that there are no qualifying hands during a Qualifying Period, the current Initial Giveaway will roll to the next Qualifying Period. If it is the final Qualifying Period for the day, then there will be no winner, and the funds will remain in the Promotional Pool.
12. The Winning High Hands will be paid from a promotional pool funded by The Venetian Bad Beat Jackpot ("Promotional Pool"). See The Venetian Bad Beat Jackpot Rules for details.
13. Winner must be present at the conclusion of the Qualifying Period. If Winner is not present, Initial or Matching Giveaway will be forfeited. Forfeited Initial or Matching Giveaway will remain in the Promotional Pool.
14. Winners must present valid ID and a Grazie® card to collect Initial or Matching Giveaway. Initial or Matching Giveaway will be forfeited if Winner refuses to provide valid ID and a Grazie card. Forfeited Initial or Matching Giveaway will remain in the Promotional Pool.
15. If Winner is willing but unable to produce valid ID and a Grazie card at the conclusion of the Qualifying Period, he or she will have seven (7) days to claim the Initial or Matching Giveaway at the Poker Room Cage. Initial or Matching Giveaway will be forfeited if Winner does not provide valid ID and Grazie card within 7 days. Forfeited Initial or Matching Giveaway will remain in the Promotional Pool.
16. Winner is responsible for paying any and all taxes and fees in connection with claiming the Initial or Matching Giveaway.
17. Initial or Matching Giveaway are non-transferable.
18. The High Hand Giveaway is subject to The Venetian Poker Rewards Terms and Conditions and Grazie Terms and Conditions.
19. The Venetian Resort Management is not responsible for any computer malfunctions.
20. The Venetian Resort Management reserves the right to cancel the High Hand Giveaway, amend the High Hand Giveaway rules, change the High Hand Giveaway dates, or adjust the High Hand Giveaway structure in its sole and absolute discretion without prior notice.
21. The Venetian Resort Management reserves all rights. All disputes and subsequent decisions by Management are final and binding.
22. Failure to adhere to the High Hand Giveaway rules will result in disqualification and/or forfeiture of any winnings.
